



Power Tool Motorsports, Drag Racing Rules:

1. Race distance: 65 feet
2. Race track is plywood or OSB.
3. Track is 12 inches wide and 3.5 inches deep.
4. Racers drive mechanisms must be contained within the interior surfaces of track and side rails.
5. Top of rails may only be used for rollers or slides of racer.
6. Racers' bodies may protrude from the top and side of racetrack but cannot impede opponent's racers. Therefore they cannot extend sideways more than 6 inches horizontally from exterior edge of track, and be no more than 24" tall.
7. Drive mechanism must be powered by a handheld power tool. This can be one used for construction, shop work, lawn work, or kitchen work. Once again, the mechanism must be a hand held tool, no bench or floor mounted tools allowed.
8. No gasoline or battery powered hand tools.
9. No radio controlled cars.
10. Racer must be powered by 120 volt electricity.
11. Racers in danger of liftoff must have zipline.
12. No fire or flaming cars allowed.
13. Finish line judge calls winner.
14. Racers may be disqualified for breaking rules or acting in a belligerent or unsafe manner.
15. Racers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by responsible adult in racing cage.
16. No consumption of alcohol by racers allowed during race.
17. Drivers must obey race officials.
18. A double elimination bracket system will be used to determine class winners.
19. Team winners will be determined by the average of their top three finishes.
20. Power Tool Motorsports reserves the rights to change and update rules as needs arise.

Possible Tools:

Construction and shop:

Saws, drills, grinders, belt sanders, buffers, routers, etc.

Lawn:

Weedwacker, hedge clippers, chainsaws, etc.

Home and kitchens:

Hand mixers, vacuum cleaners, blenders and food processors (allowed even though theoretically these are bench equipment), etc.
